SPECIFICATIONS

Each artist may submit one painting. All work will be hung.
No canvas may exceed 36 inches in any direction.

ENTRY FEE

\$30 entry fee. Fee will be collected at drop off.
There is no preregistration.

ELIGIBILITY

This exhibition is open to members of Indiana Plein Air Painters Association. Paintings must have been completed within the past two years and should represent you best plein air effort. No wet paintings allowed.

FRAMING

All work must be properly framed. We will not be responsible for works damaged through faulty wiring or framing. Use flat strap wires only (no sawtooth or clip frame hangers). Works on paper must be glazed.

SALES

All works must be for sale. Artists will receive 60% for each painting sold. Commission will be split between IPAPA and Harrison Center. Sales tax will be collected and paid by the Harrison Center. Prices on the entry form must reflect this commission.

Accepted works may NOT be withdrawn prior to the close of the exhibition.

Cynthia Young, CFRM



Cynthia Young, Executive Director of the SullivanMunce Cultural Center in Zionsville, and an artist herself earned a BFA in Interior/Environmental Design from Ball State University. Young is a published interior designer and worked 20 years creating residential interiors for clients in Indianapolis, Michigan, Chicago, IL, and Scottsdale, AZ. She also created commercial interiors for business offices, retail shops, and the Indy Car racing industry. In 2007, Young became the Art Center Director for the SullivanMunce Cultural Center in Zionsville and was then named Executive Director in 2013. She provides leadership and direction for the art center, history museum, and genealogy library.

Young is a published fine artist. She is a painter and was named one of the Hoosier Women Artists in 2020 by Lieutenant Governor Suzanne Crouch. Young has also created multiple murals and public art projects in Zionsville including a Dahlia traffic box at 106th and Zionsville Road and the Walking Man Sculpture located on the Zionsville Town Hall grounds and several school murals.

Young lives in Zionsville with her husband, Monty. She has a home studio and continues to paint despite a busy schedule!
